at the VFW in Forest Lake, MN

Meeting called to order at 12:30 by Pres. Merle

There being no secretary present, Merle asked Barb to take minutes.

Secretary's report - Motion by Dawn 2nd by Mia to approve as read
Motion carried.

Treasurer's report - Larry Bartells absent.

Motion by Kathy, 2nd by Mary to approve the report dated February 27. Motion carried.

Bills presented - \$44 for postage for newsletter to Holly Tuckner and \$60 for rental of
1/2 a booth at the Cowboy/Cowgirl Gathering in Hinckley, MN on March 12.

Motion by Mary, 2nd by Mia to approve payment. Motion carried.
